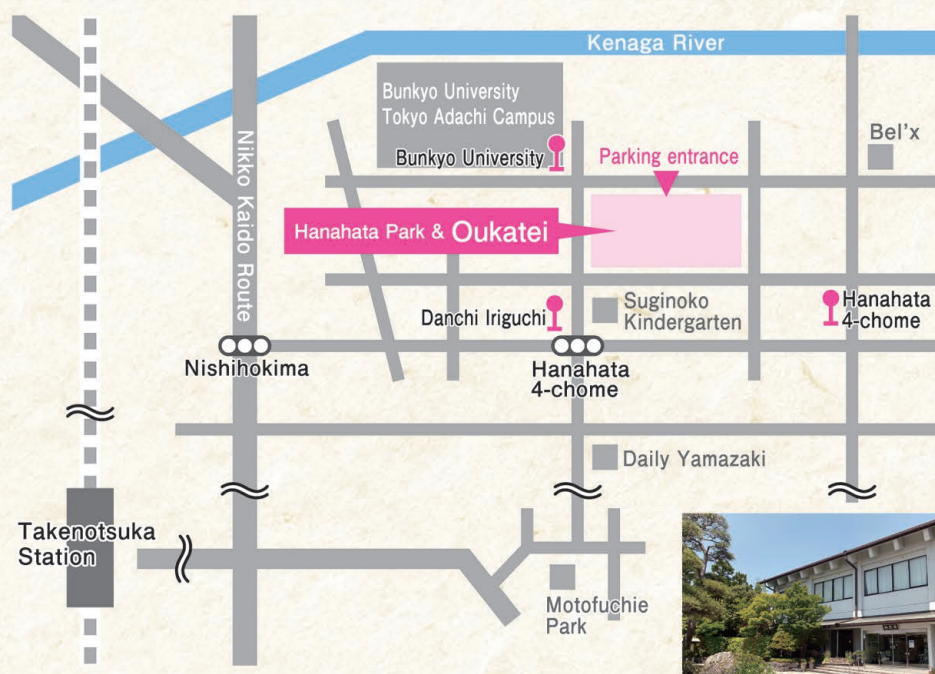

Hanahata Memorial Garden and Oukatei

The Hanahata Memorial Garden is enclosed by stone walls and traditional earthen fences. The setting, with moats flowing along the south and west sides, evokes the appearance of an old Japanese castle. Inside the garden, visitors can enjoy seasonal flowers, as well as a waterfall, pond, stream, and artificial hill. In addition, the park's gathering facility Oukatei has a cafe, Japanese-style and Western-style rooms with views of the garden, and a tea room with a tea garden, which can be used for multiple purposes.

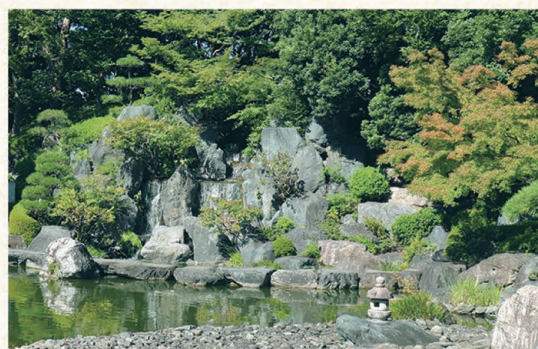
Shibayama Hill

Located near the center of the garden by the pond, this gently sloping grassy hill offers a calm and soothing view of the landscape.



Great Waterfall

This impressive waterfall features stepped stonework made with Sanbaseki rocks, "which are prized as ornamental garden stones. The three-tiered cascade creates a refreshing atmosphere."



Suhama Beach and Misaki Lantern

Suhama Beach, an area paved with stones, represents the shoreline. Together with the Misaki Lantern, which evokes the image of a lighthouse, the scene creates a coastal landscape within the garden.

Reservation Information

Reservation start date: The first day of the month two months prior to the intended date of use. (If the 1st falls on a park holiday, reservations begin the following day. For January, from the 5th.)

Phone reservations: Provisional reservations can be made by phone from 9:00 a.m. on the reservation start date. (First come, first served.)

*Reservations for wedding receptions can be made up to six months in advance.

*After making a provisional reservation by phone, please complete payment within four days, including the day of reservation.

*Payment can be made either by bank transfer or in cash at the Oukatei front desk.

*For the tearoom on the 1st floor, you must reserve both Fudanan and Tsuginoma (the adjoining room) or all rooms. Reservation of Mizuya (the preparation area) alone is not available.

*The waiting room on the 2nd floor can only be used in conjunction with a Western-style room. Reservation of the waiting room alone is not available.

*No kitchen facilities are available.

*Use of the facility for commercial purposes, religious activities, product sales, or funerals is not permitted.
